EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2024 has been a formative and transformative year for Annot Inc., marked by significant strides in realizing our vision of empowering young people through education. This year, we successfully launched our programs in both Zimbabwe and the United States, furthering our mission to provide underserved children with access to quality education.

In the United States, we hosted our first event in Washington, DC, to launch the Educate My Village program. The event brought together supporters, members of the diaspora, and key stakeholders to advance our mission. Additionally, we introduced the Navigating U.S. Education program, designed to provide guidance and support to students aspiring to pursue higher education in the United States.

In Zimbabwe, we launched the Annot Scholarship Program, offering educational scholarships and mentorship to students from rural communities. Another notable highlight was our inaugural in-person event in Zimbabwe, Navigating U.S. Education, which drew hundreds of high school students from across the country. Alongside these program launches, Annot Inc. achieved several key milestones. We became a verified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and secured technology grants from Google and Microsoft. These accomplishments have strengthened our foundation and expanded our capacity to create meaningful impact.

As the new year begins, we take pride in our accomplishments while setting ambitious goals for 2025. Our objectives for the coming year include providing scholarships, mentorship, and digital skills training to 1,000 learners, as well as investing in the establishment of learning centers in Africa. We remain steadfast in our commitment to enhancing educational access and empowering the next generation to lead transformative change in their communities.

01. Infrastructure Development in Schools

- Hosted workshops and mentorship sessions for 1,000+ students, focusing on life skills, career guidance, and personal development.


04. Nonprofit Verification and Grants



- We launched a Scholarship program with 20 students at Materera Primary School




Scholarship Expansion
